# Our history: serving Flatirons communities for 25 years

Flatirons Habitat was chartered as a Habitat for Humanity International affiliate in 1993. Since then, we have served nearly 100 families locally by building, repairing, and rehabilitating homes. We have also funded the construction of more than 130 homes internationally.

Flatirons Habitat has an open-door policy: All who believe everyone needs a decent, affordable place to live are welcome to help with our work, regardless of race, religion, age, gender, political views, or any other of the distinctions that too often divide people.



# Our Projects

## **Current & Upcoming Builds**

King's Ridge (Boulder)



Construction on this East Boulder triplex began in mid-June 2018 and is slated for completion in early 2019. This build will provide affordable housing for three families.

#### 22nd & Violet (Boulder)



The 22nd and Violet build will be Flatirons Habitat's biggest-ever project, designed to provide 19 units of affordable housing. Volunteer opportunities are slated to begin by Fall 2019.

### Palo Park (Boulder)



Flatirons Habitat is developing nine units of affordable housing at Palo Park in Boulder in conjunction with Boulder Housing Partners. Volunteer opportunities will begin in Spring 2019.
